Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

At the Last Supper which we commemorated on Holy Thursday, Jesus took bread and wine and instituted the Eucharist, instructing the Apostles to "Do This in Memory of Me." (1 Cor. 11:24)

When we come together for the celebration of Mass, we not only experience our unity as living members of the Body of Christ, but we also receive Him — body and blood, soul and divinity — in the Holy Eucharist. This is so, precisely because He is not to be found among the dead, but among the living, and that is our Easter joy.

During this Easter season, we are called to recognize the greatness of His

sacrifice and the incredible gift of life and salvation that He has won for us. The death and resurrection of Christ are the turning point of history and the foundation of our faith. Through His death, He bore the weight of our sins, offering Himself as the perfect sacrifice to reconcile us with God. His resurrection is the victory of life over death, of light over darkness, of good over evil. In His resurrection, we find hope for our own lives, knowing that through, with and in Him we too can find newness of life and the promise of eternity.

Just as the Apostles, seeing the Risen Christ, were moved from despair to

rejoicing, we too are called to let God's love transform our minds and hearts.

My prayer this Easter Season is for all of the members of our Archdiocese to experience the redemptive love of

Christ through participation at Sunday Mass. From

there we are sent forth to be loving, merciful and charitable toward others, to share the good news of Jesus Christ by joining our voices with those of His first disciples in acclaiming, "The Lord is risen! He is truly risen!"

May the peace of the Risen Christ truly be with you, and may the great joy of Easter fill your hearts and lives in this season and throughout the year. "Alleluia!"

The Meaning of Easter Triduum

Sundown on Maundy Thursday to sundown on Easter Sunday is considered the most solemn part of the liturgical year. This three-day period is referred to as the Easter Triduum. The Triduum reaches its high point in the Easter Vigil, and closes with evening prayer on Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, continues through the Good Friday liturgy, and concludes with the solemn Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil. The unitive nature of this celebration finds itself in the person of Our Lord Jesus. For a clearer understanding of this single celebration, let us cast a glance on the three days separately.

Maundy Thursday comes from the Latin word, *Mandatum*, meaning Command. This is Christ's command to love our fellow human beings as He loved us. On this evening, we commemorate three institutions in one celebration of Love: the institution of the Holy Eucharist, the institution of the Priesthood; and Fraternal Love (symbolized by the washing of the feet of the apostles.)

Good Friday truly IS good - because it represents the ultimate act of love and redemption for humanity's sins through the death of Christ.

Death is not just physically dying. For us, it is going to the full depth of our existence and hitting the absolute bottom – arriving at a state where we are not in control. We may well experience many of these deaths throughout our lives ... and what do we do at these points? Far too many of us turn bitter, looking for someone to blame and closing down - thereby experiencing a true death where no further growth is possible. However, when we actually do hit bottom (even, ironically, being suffocated by our sins) and yet emerge renewed and strengthened on the other side - and it dawns on us that we have been rescued and restored by another larger power or source that is not our own – then every day becomes our Good Friday.

In today's celebration, God uses the most ingenious method to transform the human soul. He wields that which would normally destroy us (the tragic, sorrowful, painful, injustice), to transform us. Even though we may be in the grip of woe, we are still invited to trust. This is the lesson Jesus taught us as He cried out, "Father into your hands I commend my spirit." Through this celebration of Good Friday, Jesus teaches us that there is a different way for us to regard the pain, sadness, and suffering we find in life. He gives us the depth of hope to be able to say, "even in the horrible, ignominious sufferings in life, God is still with us." This is what Jesus was doing for us on Good Friday.

Holy Saturday is a great day of waiting, wondering how it could be. It is a gestation time. It may seem as if nothing is happening but, in reality, something or someone is building a bridge for us in darkness. It is not our own effort, our own merit, our own purity, or our own perfection that carries us across the line and into the Promised Land. We are carried across by an unearned Grace that none of us deserve.

Easter Sunday is the Solemn day of an empty tomb. It is the day which proves, beyond all doubt, that Death has lost – and cannot ever win. In Christ, humanity has finally been made indestructible. Death, which could have destroyed us, has instead been forced to serve the purpose of salvation - transforming us and enlightening us. By defeating Death, Jesus teaches us how to trust, hope and love.

Through his death and resurrection, Jesus has become a statement about how reality works. The correct way of speaking about the feast of the resurrection is not that "Jesus rose from the dead" - as if it was self-generated miracle. The correct way to describe it is that "Jesus was raised from the dead by the Father" – so as to reveal His Son to the world as the map, the blueprint, the promise, the pledge, the guarantee of what is happening everywhere. What you say about Jesus is what you say about reality, all summed up in one person, Jesus - who suffered, died, and was raised from the dead by the Father.

My dear friends in Christ, without the preparation created by these first days of the Triduum, all the joyful noises and conformities to mystery that envelope us at Easter could not be so profoundly grasped by us - mere humans.

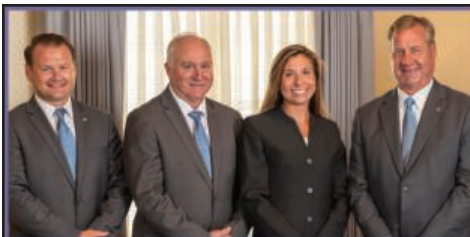

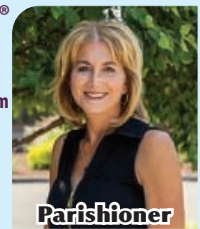
