Regarding the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, December 9, 2024.

From Archbishop Christopher J. Coyne

A recent communication from the Vatican's Dicastery for Legislative Texts has offered a ruling regarding whether Catholics in the United States must still attend Mass on holy days of obligation when they are transferred to Mondays or Saturdays, correcting a long-standing practice in the U.S. Church. The Dicastery stated that according to Canon Law, all of the feasts in question "are always days of obligation ... even when the aforementioned transfer of the feast occurs."

This ruling is contrary to the complementary norms of the USCCB which have been in effect for a number of years, namely that when certain feast days fall on a Saturday or Monday, the obligation to attend Mass on that day is "abrogated."

Moving forward, the Conference and the Archdiocese of Hartford will obviously adjust its norms and its liturgical calendar to follow the instruction from the Dicastery. **However, since many parishes and families already have in place the schedules for Advent and Christmas and given the short notice of this ruling, as Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Hartford, I grant a dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception to all the faithful present in the Archdiocese of Hartford on December 9 of this year.**

That having been said, I strongly urge all Catholics to attend Mass on that day to honor the Blessed Mother and her Immaculate Conception and to see their attendance at Mass as a privilege, a privilege to join in the liturgies of the Church on such a beautiful day of celebration. Each of us has freely taken on the discipline of the church in matters of belief and practice, one of which is the duty to celebrate Mass on particular Solemnities of the Church. I hope that all of us do so because we want to and not just because we are "obligated."

TAKING A PRAYER WALK IN ROCKY HILL

Before her passing at age 91 this past July, Jeannine Laraia watched her nephew, Father George Couturier, celebrate Mass at one two churches in Rocky Hill that make up St. Josephine Bakhita Parish.

Laraia, a Port Charlotte, Fla., resident, watched a livestream of the Mass on her computer by visiting the parish website, saintjosephinebakhita.org.

"She would usually watch Mass every Sunday at St. Elizabeth Seton Church," Father Couturier says of his aunt. After her passing, he celebrated her funeral Mass at the church.

As a gift to the priest in memory of his aunt, the parish staff planted a crepe myrtle tree on the campus of St. Elizabeth Seton Church, part of St. Josephine Bakhita Parish.

The fast-growing tree, which can withstand cold temperatures, blooms with bright colors in the warmer weather and produces fall foliage in the cooler temperatures.

Planted this past August, the tree is the newest addition to the grounds of St. Elizabeth Seton Church, which offers several outdoor places for group or private prayer in addition to beautiful trees, shrubs, perennials and flowers.

"There are always people planting on the campuses," says Father Couturier. "People often drive by and say a prayer." The campus was a popular walking spot during the coronavirus pandemic, the priest adds.

On the grounds of St. Elizabeth Seton Church, a garden devoted to Mary is a good spot for prayer. A sheltered gazebo sits in a shaded spot opposite the rectory. Benches on the church porch also offer a quiet place for reflection. A Marian meditation prayer garden was dedicated in September 2020.

St. James Church, also part of the parish, offers several outdoor spots of its own along a prayer path constructed for meditative walking and prayer. They include a labyrinth next to the parish center as well as benches between two buildings on the property.

Another prayerful area on the St. James campus is a statue of Jesus Christ situated behind the parish center. Last year, a shrine to St. Anthony of Padua was rebuilt and graces a corner on the backside of the property.

In addition to the outdoor places for prayer and walking, books are available to read on church properties or to take home. Check out the selections in the Little Free Libraries located on both church campuses.

St. James Church is located at 767 Elm St., Rocky Hill. A few miles away, St. Elizabeth Seton Church is located at 280 Brook St., also in Rocky Hill. The grounds of both churches are open to the public daily for walking and prayer.
